Plenty of pens of better conformation lambs sold easily in excess of the 400p/kg topping at 430p/kg for 41kg Beltexs selling to £176 with 40kg Beltex lambs to £170 all consigned by R Mudd & Sons, Cubeck. Heavy weight texel lambs topped at £186 from J Scarr & Sons, Askrigg weighing 52kg purchased by Westmorland Services Limited. Following this at £182 was 44kg Texel lambs from R Mudd & Sons, Cubeck with the same price achieved for Texel lambs from RC Whitehead & Son, West Burton with the consignment from JM Dickeson, Middleton in Teesdale topping at £181. Suffolk lambs topped at £179 twice for 44kg lambs from JR & LA Capstick, Killington. There was plenty more lambs selling in the late one hundred and seventies.
