#### 1411 PRIME LAMBS

The weekly sale of prime lambs sold to a stronger trade with more demand from buyers around the ring. The overall market average was 285p/kg. Handy weighted continental lambs well finished regularly sold in excess of the 300p/kg. Heavy weighted lambs continue to sell to a strong trade. The trade topped at £180 for a 50kg Beltex lamb from SD Thompson, Aysgarth which was purchased by C Steadman Butchers, Kirkby Stephen who also purchased a Beltex lamb from JR & LA Capstick, Killington that sold for £172 or 366p/kg. Heavy weight Texel sold to a top of £173 from A Lodge, Malham Moor followed by £172 from JA Alderson, Barras. Plenty of pens of heavy weight continental selling between £150 and £160. Heavy weight Cheviots from Megan Hallam sold to £174. Hawes auction once again proved itself the place to sell mule prime lambs with all forward averaging £132.98. The trade for mule lambs topped at £160 from P Hallam, Horton in Ribblesdale and £150 from R Wood & Son, Aysgarth. Mule lambs weighing in the early fifty-kilogram range sold in the early to mid-one hundred and forties regularly. Mule lambs weighing in the high end of the forty-kilogram range regularly sold in the mid one hundred and thirties.

Good to welcome more horned lambs forward selling to a keen audience of bidders. Swaledale lambs sold to a top of £140 weighing 52kg from JE Cowperthwaite, Eldroth with 48kg Swale lambs from same home. The consignment of Swaledale lambs from P Hallam, Horton in Ribblesdale sold to £135.50 and £134. This was followed by £130.50 from JA Alderson, Barras.
