Second Annual Show & Sale of Continental and Suffolk Gimmer Lambs

The second annual show and sale of Continental and Suffolk gimmer lambs saw a much-increased entry, with the event fast gaining popularity amongst both vendors and purchasers. A special thank you goes to our judge, Robert Atkinson of Scorton, for giving his time and expertise, with further thanks to our sponsors, O'Reillys Accountants.

The first prize Continental gimmer lambs, consigned by JS & D Cloughton & Son, Bainbridge, went on to take the champion rosette and sold for the top price of the day at £195.

In the Suffolk section, the first prize pen of gimmer lambs from D. Alderson, Barnard Castle, sold for £168, with further pens from the same home selling to £170. Trade for Suffolk gimmer lambs peaked at £181 for Suffolk x Cheviot lambs from Thrimby Farms, Penrith, with additional pens from the same home selling to £162.

Beltex lambs were also well received, with JC & N Throup, Skipton, selling Texel x Mule gimmer lambs to £166 and £164.

Fantastic trade once again for Store Lambs with plenty of buyers round the ring looking for power but small long keep lambs were much better than expected. Topping the trade were some smart Texels tight skinned for PF Goodall at £142 followed by some powerful lambs from T & G Farrow at £130 some nice sorts forward with the Texels although more longer keep lambs but they still averaged over the £100 mark for 730 sold. Some well meated Hampshire downs came next at £121.50, £114, £105 all for DH & JR Lowther, Northallerton. Not many Suffolks in but some nice sorts from C Hird & Son made £118 and £110. Beltex wouldn't be heavy but sold really well with Elm Gill at £110 and LM Staley at £109 with JA & E Metcalfe at £108.50. Once again thought we had a grand show of 1420 Mule Lambs that averaged £100.30 only £2 less than the last sale, plenty of quality well framed lambs forward. JS & D Cloughton & Son with their 1st prize pen of 20 sold to £122.50 followed by 2nd prize from SJ Pedley at £121 and 3rd prize from JW Porter & Sons £116.50 with 30 lots including some big runs of lambs over the £100 mark. Hawes is definitely the place of choice if you are looking for quality Mules.
