



LIVESTOCK MARKET REPORT

TUESDAY 23rd DECEMBER 2025

Forward: 2023 Sheep comprising 1751 Prime Lambs and 272 Cast Ewes and Rams.

PRIME LAMBS

Continental and Mule lambs were very much in festive demand at Hawes, as prime lambs nationwide enjoyed a welcome lift in prices, with a strong entry of 1,751 forward. Handy-weight continental lambs once again led the way, selling exceptionally well, with heavy-weight continentals easily £10 up on the week. Mule lambs also joined the Christmas cheer, returning an improved trade and averaging just shy of 310p/kg, with an overall market average of 315p/kg.

Heavy-weight continental lambs provided plenty of sparkle, with the best types selling well in excess of £180 and peaking at £190 from Libby Winspear, Hawes, fittingly achieved on her birthday with a standout pen of heavy-weight Texels. This was closely followed by £188 and £183 from Whyte and Percival, Bainbridge, while W.A. Dinsdale & Son, Grinton, sold heavy-weight Texels to £185. Plenty more heavy-weight lambs changed hands in the region of £180. Heavy-weight Beltex lambs topped at £180 from D. Hodgson, Askrigg. Handy-weight continental lambs (38–45kg) proved the trade of the day, regularly selling around 350p/kg for well-fleshed sorts, with numerous pens exceeding this level and a festive peak of 388p/kg from Seth Guy, Hawes.

A good seasonal entry of Mule lambs was forward once again and met with plenty of demand. Heavy-weight Mules topped at £164 from R. & R. Gornall, Dent, followed by £159 from S.D. Thompson, Aysgarth, and J. Scarr & Sons, Askrigg. Further pens sold to £158.50 from W.A. Dinsdale & Son, Grinton, with plenty of Mule lambs trading comfortably in the one hundreds and fifties. All Mules forward averaged just shy of 310p/kg.

Horned lambs also enjoyed a bright trade, with Dalesbreds selling to £139 from Bainbridge Bros, Marrick. Scotch Blackface lambs peaked at £135 from P. Turnbull, Whitby, while Swaledales topped at £130 from J. Scarr & Sons, Askrigg (46kg) and £130 from G. Calvert & Sons, Keld (47kg).

Ewe trade up in all departments today with buyers wanting to stock up before Christmas. Topping the trade was a smart Charollais Ewe from JK Foster at £222. A Smart BFL Ewe from JW & JH Burton & Son achieved £190 followed with two from JK Foster at £168. Suffolks were brought from Sledmere Estate and achieved £186, £178 & £172. The same good consignment topped the Cheviot section at £180 & £174. Texel Ewes topped at £170 for both K Calvert Ltd at £170 followed by Breck House at £168. Horned Ewes today were topped twice by the same vendor, Elm Gill having both Swaledales & Blackface achieving £126 then two vendors achieved £120 for Swaledales, M Bell & Son & G Barraclough followed by P Turnbull with £120 for Blackface Ewes. Medium horned Ewes would be £85-£100 with the leanest between £55-£75. Few Rams forward with Texels at £144 & £140 from N Hobson and J & JH Whaley Suffolks at £140 and Swaledales topped at £136 for JW Porter & Sons with JL & JA Sunter at £122.
