PRIME LAMBS

The weekly sale of prime lambs saw an increased entry of 1515 forward, with these numbers easily handled by a busy ring of buyers at Hawes Auction. Lambs sold to a nice trade with Mule lambs noticeable sharper trade and buyers keener for them.

Heavy weighted lambs continue to add up the best selling to a top of £177 from TW Clark & Sons, Alne for heavy weight Texels followed by the consignment of heavy weight texels from J Rukin & Son, Keld selling to £175, £170 x2 and £166. Other leading prices for heavy weight Texels were £172 from R Capstick & Son, Ingleton and £168 from RS Harker & Son, Grayrigg. There was plenty more pens selling in the one hundred and sixties.

Handy weighted Continental and Suffolk lambs that were well finished regularly sold in excess of the 300p/kg with best types selling to 360p/kg for 44kg Beltex lambs from JR & LA Capstick, Killington.

Mule lambs sold to a top of £146 for heavy weight from JS & S Atkinson, Scorton followed by £142 from TW Clark & Sons, Alne with plenty of pens of well finished mule lambs selling towards the £140 mark. The overall market average was 290p/kg to include larger runs of mule and horned lambs.

SALE OF BREEDING SHEEP

688 Breeding sheep comprising 483 Breeding Ewes, 156 Shearlings & 49 Gimmer Lambs.

The reintroduced sale of crossed Swaledale ewes to include the sale of cheviot breeding sheep and lowland ewes would be deemed a great success with a busy ring of local and travelled buyers ensuring a strong trade. The sale commenced Swaledale ewes that topped at £172 for 2 crop ewes from WT Metcalfe & Son, Burtersett with 2 and 3 crop Swaledale ewes selling to £138 from JR & SL Pratt, Thornton Rust. There was plenty of crossed ewes selling between £80 and £100.

Cheviot breeding sheep were in big demand and more easily could have been sold to the advantage of vendors. The consignment from Thrimby Farms, Penrith sold shearlings to a top £280. One and two crops sold to £272 and £250 x2. The three and four crops sold to £270 and £252 with the entire consignment averaged £240. Raby Farms, Preesall sold Cheviot shearlings to £228 and £225. Cheviot gimmer lambs topped at £130 and £128 from KM & KJ Curwen, Abbeystead. The consignment from RMS Livestock topped at £155 for Texdale gimmer shearlings.
