

HAWES FARMERS AUCTION MART CO LTD LIVESTOCK MARKET REPORT

TUESDAY 7TH OCTOBER 2025

Forward: 8 Calves 1593 Sheep comprising 1205 Prime Lambs, 388 Cast Ewes and Rams

PRIME LAMBS

There was a slight increase in the number of prime lambs forward at Hawes today. A two-tiered trade was evident, with buyer's keen for well-fed, properly finished lambs, while showing caution toward the grass-fed, leaner types. The overall market average stood at 289p/kg, very similar to the previous week.

Leading the trade was a consignment from JR & LA Capstick, Killington, who sold 51kg Beltex lambs to £171. Heavyweight Texel lambs topped at £170 on three occasions — from D & A Cowperthwaite, Garsdale; B Clarkson, Bainbridge; and Whyte & Percival — with others to £166 from B Spence & Sons, Aysgarth. The Suffolk trade peaked at £165 twice, both for Suffolk lambs from L Bosomworth, Northallerton. Plenty more heavy lambs sold in the region of £160.

Well-fleshed, handy-weight lambs continued to sell readily at around 300p/kg, while lighter, leaner types would likely be better suited to the store lamb market.

Mule lambs peaked at £147 from WA Dinsdale & Son, Grinton, followed by £143 from JS & S Atkinson, Scorton, and £141 from DL Mudd and R & E Cowperthwaite. Many more pens of Mules sold in the £130s. The best-meated Mule lambs reached 300p/kg for 46kg lambs from JW & JH Burton & Son, Gayle.
