The prime hogg trade was sharper this week with more interest from the buyers. It was handy weighted and light weights that have taken the lift with well bred heavy weights sharper. Heavy weight mule and Swaledale tups very similar trade to previous week.

The consignment from JR & LA Capstick lead the way selling to a top of £188 for 63kg Texel hogs with others from the same home to £176, £174 and £172 all purchased by Dave Morland of Westmorland Services. Whom also purchased the heavy weight texels from G Harker & Son, Arkengarthdale selling to £171. Heavy weight Leicester hogs sold to a top of £170 from R & PR Banks & Son, Walden. Handy weighted well fleshed continental hogs in strong demand selling between 320p/kg and 370p/kg. more of these are required to fill buyers requirements.

Mule hogs sold to a top of £147 from K & A Woof, Marsett followed by £145 from JS & S Atkinson, Scorton. Horned hogs sold to £142 from R & PR Banks & Son, Walden for Swaledales followed by Dalesbreds selling to £141 from BD & PM Gill & Son, Ingleton.
