LIVESTOCK MARKET REPORT

TUESDAY 11TH FEBRUARY 2025

Forward: 7 Calves 2294 Sheep comprising 2023 Prime Hogs & 175 Cast Ewes & Rams, 96 Breeding Sheep.

There was another great entry of prime hogs forward in Hawes with over 2000 forward in which more could have easily been sold to the advantage of vendors. It was wonderful to see new and returning faces showing stock in Hawes, please do not hesitate to come and give us a try with your stock.

A highlight of the day was the show of pens of five prime Swaledale hogs kindly sponsored by B District Swaledale Sheep Breeders Association and the Swaledale Sheep Breeders Association. A wonderful line up of a dozen pens forward saw the first prize rosette awarded to T Dent & Son, Swinithwaite with 54kg hogs selling to £163. The blue rosette was won by GJ & ME Walker & Son, Dunsop Bridge with 47kg hogs to £156 and the yellow rosette going to JS & D Cloughton & Son, Bainbridge with 46kg hogs £150.50. Swaledale's throughout the day eagerly sought after at Hawes. Plenty of pens of heavy weight Swaledale hogs selling in one hundred and fifties with the leading average of Swaledales a consignment of 38 heavy weights from WE & BE Wilson, Mungrisedale averaging £155.41. Dalebred hogs topped at £154.50 from A & M Brennand and Son, Chapel Le Dale.

The market this week was topped by 49kg Texel hogs from A Lodge, Malham Moor selling to £172 purchased by C Steadman, Butchers Kirkby Stephen. This was followed by heavy weight Zwartble x hogs from FA Broadwith & Son, Ripon selling to £170.50 with plenty others selling in the one hundred and sixties. Handy weighted continental well fleshed hogs weighing between 39kg to 46kg very good to sell with more of this specification required to fill purchaser's needs.

The mule trade was sharper once again with heavy weights topping at £160 from WA Lambert & Son, Selside. This was followed by Bainbridge Bros, Marrick selling to £159.50 who sold a pen full of 59 mules at 48kg to £157. Mules weighing between 44kg and 49kg in the most demand within specification mules averaging 325p/kg. There was a healthy market average of 315p/kg.

BREEDING INLAMB SHEEP

The sale of in lamb breeding sheep created much interest with many looking to purchase and more easily could have been sold to vendor's advantage. The highlight of the sale was the consignment of well-bred Swaledale shearlings to three crop ewes from Jack Hallam, Whitby. Scanned in lamb to the Leicester due to lamb at the start of April. It was the pens of shearlings that stole the headlines selling to a top of £248 twice with other pens to £245. The one crop ewes sold to £240 and £235. The two crop ewes sold to £222 and full-mouthed ewes sold to £195. The full consignment from Jack Hallam averaged £231.82. A pen of Scotch Blackfaced 1 crop ewes from Tom Ladds, Kendal scanned in lamb to the Leicester tup sold to £160.
