Forward: 1766 Sheep comprising 1415 Prime Hogs, 325 Cast Ewes and Rams and 26 Breeding Gimmer Hogs.

PRIME HOGGS

A very seasonal entry of prime hogs as to be expected as many come to the end of their annual consignment. The trade remains very similar to the previous week with well fleshed quality hogs short in supply and more required each week to meet buyers' requirements. Once again well finished handy weighted continental hogs in most demand selling between 340p/kg and 360p/kg with best Beltex hogs topping at 385p/kg from CT & JE Willoughby, Redmire. Heavy weight hog trade continues to be similar with buyers cautious of the heavy weighted hogs regularly selling in the one fifties and into the one hundred and sixties.

A lot less mule hogs forward today as many now coming to the end of the annual consignment saw them peak at £152 from Bank House Farm, Cowan Bridge with plenty more pens selling in the region of one hundred and fifty pound.

Once again, a bumper entry of horned hogs in Hawes being keenly sought after once again. Leading the way with horned hogs was the consignment of Swaledale's from K & GJ Huck, Austwick selling 50kg hogs to £154. Dalesbred hogs sold to top of £153.50 from M/s Coates, Stainforth who sold other pens of Dalebreds to £151.50 at 47kg.

Texels, we had a quality consignment from M & K Chippendale with lots at £255, £242, £238 and £215. Suffolks were headed by same vendor at £235, Mules not many forward but were topped by TW Clark & Sons at £168 with 2 lots at £160 from M & P Carter and G Mudd. Some quality horned ewes forward today. Top price was a Blackface from W Tyreman & Sons at £148, £122 and £94. Roughfells from SW & TA Milner had a large consignment topping at £142 with further lots at £117 and £107. Swaledale ewes topped at £120 x2 for JA Alderson and H Kirkbride & Son, with £116 for both DJ Amsden and G Mudd with 8 lots between £110 or above. 20 Rams forward topping at £170 for a BFL from SD Thompson

and a Texel x from JW & JH Burton & Son. Swaledale rams topped at £142 for R Wood & Son. Quality ewes needed once again next week.
