PRIME HOGGS

There as another great entry of prime hogs forward in Hawes auction with sheep present from throughout the Northern counties in which more easily could have been sold to the advantage of the vendor. All specifications of hogs a sharper trade with buyers keen to fill their orders today.

Heavy weights another sharp trade today in Hawes peaking at £192 for 52kg Beltex hogs from JR & LA Capstick, Killington purchased by C Steadman Butchers Kirkby Stephen. Heavy weight Texels sold to a top of £188 from FA Broadwith & Sons, Ripon with Suffolks from the same home sold selling to £184. This was followed by the consignment from TW Clark & Sons, York selling heavy Texels to £184 and £179.50 followed by £179 from R Mudd & Sons, Cubeck. Heavy weight Leicester hogs sold to a top of £181 from WA Dinsdale & son, Grinton. Plenty of pens of hogs over 50kg easily selling in excess of £170.

Handy weighted continental hogs another cracking trade in which more could have easily been sold with well finished commercial hogs selling between 345-355p/kg with better types selling in excess of that. They topped at 375p/kg for Beltexs from K Milburn & A Devlin, Sedbergh.

There was another cracking of hill hogs in Hawes today topping at £165.50 for 55kg Cheviot hogs from Megan Hallam, Horton in Ribblesdale. Mule hogs sold to a top £159 from A & H Watson, Kirkby Lonsdale.

Horned hogs sold to a top of £159 from G Harker & Son, Arkengarthdale for Swaledales followed by Dalesbreds to £157 from TW Clark & Sons, York and Rough Fells to £154 from K Milburn & A Devlin, Sedbergh who sold Scotch Blackfaces to £149. There was plenty of pens good upland hogs regularly selling in excess of the £150 mark.
