Forward: 1509 Sheep comprising 1069 Prime Lambs, 440 Cast Ewes and Rams

PRIME LAMBS

The weekly sale of prime lambs saw a smaller entry forward this week. Continental lambs met a sharper trade, easily selling at over 300p/kg, while Mule lambs sold to a trade very similar to the previous week. The overall market average was 292p/kg.

Heavy-weight Texel lambs topped at £175 from Whyte and Percival, Bainbridge. This was followed by the weekly consignment of quality Texel and Beltex lambs from JR & LA Capstick, Killington, selling to a top of £170 or 340p/kg purchased by C Steadman's Butchers, Kirkby Stephen, with others from the same home to £165. Other leading prices saw Texels to £167 from AL Dawes, Healey. Rouge lambs peaked at £163 from JR, P & RA Swainson, Horton-in-Ribblesdale, with plenty more selling around £160. Beltex lambs sold to £158 at 48kg from R Marwood & Son, Richmond, with others at 46kg reaching £154.

Masham lambs sold to £145.50 at 49kg from JR, P & RA Swainson, Horton-in-Ribblesdale. Mule lambs topped at £144 from J Allison & Sons, Arkengarthdale, followed by £142 from J Scarr & Sons, Askrigg.

Strong Ewes from DT Dinsdale & Son achieved £114 & £110 plenty of the leaner sorts today and the leanest were £30-£40 with mediums £40-£60. Blackface Ewes achieved £76 for MW Cook with K Milburn & A Devlin at £70 & £60.
