

## HAWES FARMERS AUCTION MART CO LTD LIVESTOCK MARKET REPORT

**TUESDAY 11<sup>th</sup> NOVEMBER 2025**

Forward: 1910 Sheep comprising 1682 Prime Lambs and 228 Cast Ewes and Rams.

### PRIME LAMBS

A larger entry of prime lambs met a slightly disappointing trade this week as a couple of firms not requiring lambs late in the day. The mule trade remained on a similar level to last week, with another good show of numbers forward. In total, 1,631 lambs were presented, averaging 285p/kg.

Stealing the headlines was Libby Winspear, Hawes, with her superb heavyweight, shapely Texel lambs. They topped the sale at £204 for 66kg, with others from the same home achieving £200. Texel lambs from JR & LA Capstick, Killington peaked at £170 for 51kg, purchased by C Steadman Butchers, Kirkby Stephen.

Matching that £170 top was BC Gregg, Masham, followed closely by B Clarkson, Bainbridge, whose heavyweight Texels reached £169. There was an excellent show of heavy continental lambs throughout, with plenty selling in the £150–£165 range.

Heavyweight Leicesters sold to a top of £170 twice from WA Dinsdale & Son, Grinton, who also produced some sensational heavyweight Mule lambs to £156, with many other strong Mule pens around the £150 mark.

Handy-weight continentals were a touch easier on the week, trading slightly back on last sale's stronger rates.
