Forward: 1187 Sheep comprising 646 Spring Lambs, 39 Prime Hogs & 502 Cast Ewes and Rams.

SPRING LAMBS

Trade easier on the week as reported in other markets at the start of this week. Fleshed strong lambs with weight continue to attract the highest price per kilo, as well as the price. Topping the trade with a good consignment was JR & LA Capstick with Beltex x at £218 & £216 for lambs at 53kg & 51kg. From the same vendor was the top three prices in the Texels at £207 & £199 x2, with both R Moore & Son and KJ Burrow making £198, and C & M Hugill at £196. R Marwood and Son brought a smart batch of Beltex x lambs which topped at £200 with further lots at £189, £186, £180 & £176. Some smart good skinned Suffolks forward with JR & LA Capstick topping at £197 with D Alderson at £180 and two lots from KJ Burrow at £168 & £160. Mules are starting to come and topping the trade at £186 was new vendor SK Wilson, with two lots at £172 for D Alderson & S Bell & Sons. A few lots forward today between 32-34kg, and these sold well especially if well fleshed.

CAST EWES

A good big show of cast ewes and rams with just over 500 forward, with the full range of ewes covered from the well fleshed continental to the leanest of horned ewes. All were keenly bid for and it was definitely advantageous having plenty of clipped ewes for grazing buyers to bid for. Some very smart Charollais x ewes from T Pounder topped the trade at £230 & £214. Suffolks were headed by DA & MA Brown at £212 and MW & HE Pedley at £196. Texels would not have had as much power as some weeks and sold to £210 for J Scarr & Son with DA & MA Brown at £202. PF Goodall had a shapely Beltex achieve £200. BFL topped at £182 for D Stephenson & £180 for SH TA & M Sutcliffe. Not many Mules forward and topped again by DA & MA Brown at £178 & £169. Most of the sale were Swale ewes with 375 forward. We had some cracking ewes at the top of this section with DJ Amsden at £159, SK Wilson at £151, £140 for MR Ewbank, & £138 for D Stephenson. But clipped ewes with half meat would be between £75-£90, with the leanest at £40-£65.

Only 7 rams forward topping at £236 for JH Pedley, followed at £228 for a Texel from Dixon Bros, with Swales topping at £148 for JL & JA Sunter
