### LIVESTOCK MARKET REPORT

**TUESDAY 24<sup>TH</sup> JUNE 2025**

Forward: 13 Calves, 657 Sheep comprising 313 Spring Lambs, 105 Prime Hogs, and 239 Cast Ewes and Rams.

#### **SPRING LAMBS**

There was a very similar number of prime lambs forward, selling to a comparable trade, with an average of 340p/kg. It was the heavyweight lambs that lit up the ring today, with the best types selling in excess of the £200 mark.

Leading the way was a consignment from M.E. Dinsdale, Carperby, selling heavyweight Suffolks to £222 at 61kg, with 53kg Suffolks from the same home reaching £200. A consignment of pure Charollais lambs from Kenton Foster sold heavyweights to £214 and £194.

Heavy lambs were certainly in demand, and more could have been sold to advantage. Notable sales included 50kg Texel lambs to £190 and £186 from R. Wood & Son, Aysgarth; 48kg Texel crosses to £188 from D.A. & M.A. Brown & Son, Leyburn; and 49kg Texels to £188 from J. Scarr & Sons, Askrigg.

There was plenty of better-conformation, handy-weighted lambs regularly selling between 370p/kg and 400p/kg. A larger number of hill-bred lambs were forward today, with Mule lambs topping at £141 at 46kg from D.J. Amsden, Hawes.

### **CAST EWES**

Plenty of ewes forward for the time of year and well fleshed ewes were keenly bid for. Topping the trade was two Charollais ewes from Kenton Foster @at£200 & £180. A good big Blue Faced Leicester from S Bell & Son came next at £180 and the same price was achieved for Texels from JR & LA Capstick who had further Texels at £165 & £163. Suffolks were topped with K Milburn & A Devlin at £170 followed again by JR & LA Capstick at £165. Hampshire Downs from J Bell, Ingleby Arncliffe made £162 & £152. More mules forward and tale of two halves £154 was achieved from A & TA Blades followed at £150 for both J Scarr & Sons and DA & MA Brown & Son and they saw an average of £116 with a couple of lean sorts under the £100 mark.

We saw some good strong horned ewes of various breeds with Swaledales coming out on top at £140 from JE Cowperthwaite followed by E & K Bland at £138, with nine lots of £102 or above, and all the Swales averaged £73.

Rough Fells came next at £138 & £136 from JJ & E Labbate and E & K Bland respectively with Blackface also at £136 from K Milburn
