There was an increased entry of spring lambs forward today selling to an overall market average of 322p/kg. Leading the way was a consignment from JR&LA Capstick, Killington topping at £170 for 47kg Texels purchased by M Hare of Lane End Farm Shop. This was followed by Suffolk x lambs from the same home selling to £156 purchased by The Meat Hook, Sedbergh. The consignment from DA&MA Brown & Son, Leyburn sold Texels to £155, with Texels from KJ Burrow, Dent and JM Smith, Mickleby selling to the same price. Hampshire Prime Lambs topped at £151 from K&J Stables, Durham.
