Forward: 1564 Sheep comprising 1382 Prime Hogs & 182 Cast Ewes & Rams.

PRIME HOGGS

The opening sale of prime hogs of the season saw in-specification hogs meeting plenty of demand and selling well throughout. Heavy-weighted hogs led the trade, topping at £186 from D. Hodgson, Askrigg, with a 58kg Beltex. Texels peaked at £180 from R.W. & M.R. Cooper, Spennithorne, followed closely by £179.50 from Bainbridge Bros, Marrick, with plenty more selling in excess of the £160 mark.

The Mule hogg trade reached a high of £162.50 for a pen of 34 heavy-weighted hogs from Bainbridge Bros, Marrick, followed by £158.50 from R. & P.R. Banks & Son, Walden, and £158 from R. & E. Cowperthwaite, Settle. Many more pens of Mules sold in excess of £150.

Handy-weighted export hogs sold to a top of 380p/kg for 40kg Beltex hogs from B.C. Gregg, Masham, grossing £152. The horned hogg trade topped at £155 for heavy-weighted Swaledale tups from W.A. Dinsdale & Son, Grinton. Dalesbred hogs from H. & E.M. Tiplady, West Burton, topped at £139, with a pen of 45kg Dalesbreds from the same home selling to £135.50.

Less Ewes forward today but trade was very good in all sections. Topping the trade came PJ Broughton with two Texel x Ewes at £192 and another at £155. Suffolks from HB Farms made £178 and £168 for nice fit Ewes. Mules were topped with a big Ewe from R Wood & Sons at £174 followed by B Spence & Sons at £168 with only one lot under 3128. Only 3 BFLs both from P Turnbull made £159 & £154. Well fleshed Romneys from JW & JH Burton

& Son were £145 & £140. Pen of the day was 20 Blackface's from P Turnbull topping with a massive ewe at £152 with further lots at £135 & £128. Swaledales were topped at £128 for B Spence & Sons followed by P Broughton at £120 and S bell & Sons at £110 with 10 lots above £90 and other just under. Rams topped at £172 for BFL from H & EM Tiplady followed by £162 for HB Farms and a big Roughfell from JJ & E Labbate achieving £158.
