### LIVESTOCK MARKET REPORT

**TUESDAY 25<sup>TH</sup> MARCH 2025**

Forward: 5 Calves 1895 Sheep comprising 1655 Prime Hogs, 240 Cast Ewes and Rams.

#### PRIME HOGGS

There was a bumper entry of 1655 prime hogs forward into Hawes being keenly sought after and eagerly bid for with a full variety of hogs in the market as to be expected at this time of year. Well finished in specifications hogs in demand today and well bid for. Heavy weighted hogs a shade dearer today with more interest expressed by the buyers. There was a large quantity of lightweight hogs forward, light weights with meat on in demand and being well sold. Leaner types still getting bid for but meeting realisation at times for thin hogs.

The consignment of heavy weight Beltex and Texel hogs from JR & LA Capstick, Killington lead the way selling to £172, £170 and £166.50 all purchased by the Meat Hook Butchers Shop in Sedbergh. JR & LA Capstick also topped the Suffolks at £164 purchased by C Steadman Butchers Kirkby Stephen. Once again in was the well finished handy weighted hogs in most demand selling in the region of 350p/kg topping at 382p/kg for Texel hogs from Elm Gill Farm, Mallerstang.

There was once again a large proportion of the entry forward upland hogs with the consignment of heavy weight Cheviots from RJ Lund, Garsdale selling to £164 and £163. The number of mules hogs beginning to reduce but still keenly sought after selling to a top of £154 and £153 from FA Broadwith & Sons, Ripon with other pens from £153 from K & GJ Huck, Austwick and A Lodge, Malham Moor. A highlight of the mules was the run 148 mule hogs averaging 47kg from H Morphet and Son, Austwick selling to an average of £149.11. Mule hogs weighing in the mid to late forties sold regularly towards one hundred and fifty pounds.

Once again Hawes proved the place to market horned hogs. Heavy weighted Swaledale tup hogs from S & D Robinson, Settle sold to a top of £161 with plenty more heavy weight Swaledale hogs selling in the early one hundred and fifties. Swaledale wether hogs in the mid forty-kilogram weight range in demand topping at 326p/kg from M & P Carter, Pickering with plenty of these pens selling in the region of 320p/kg and more needed filling buyers' requirements. Heavy weight Rough Fells from A & H Watson, Kirkby Lonsdale sold to £151. Some good runs of Dalesbred Hogs forward saw the consignment from WI & AM Atkinson & Son, Bleasdale top at £150 at 47kg followed by the consignment from R Capstick and Son, Ingleton top at £149 at 46kg.
