### LIVESTOCK MARKET REPORT

**TUESDAY 11<sup>TH</sup> MARCH 2025**

Forward: 6 Calves 1766 Sheep comprising 1612 Prime Hogs, 154 Cast Ewes and Rams.

#### PRIME HOGGS

The number of prime hogs continue to flow to Hawes auction. Continental handy weighted hogs a sharper trade as seen nationwide. Upland hogs a stand on strong trade with heavy weights meeting some resistance as seen in many markets. The sale includes a large number of light weight horned hogs regularly selling in the region of 300p/kg.

Heavy weight Beltex hogs from CT & JE Willoughby, Redmire lead the way selling to a top of £178 or 350p/kg at 51kg who sold heavy weight texels to a top of £164. Heavy weight Suffolk hogs sold to £165 from A Hollings, Whitby. A pen full of handy weighted texels sold to 390p/kg from WC Stones & Son, Arkengarthdale with plenty of pens selling between 350 and 380p/kg with more of these hogs required to fill buyers' requirements.

There was another large proportion of upland hogs forward again selling to a top of £160 for heavy weight mules from JS & S Atkinson, Scorton followed by other mules to £157 from K & GJ Huck, Austwick and £156 from JW & JH Burton, Gayle with plenty of pens of mule hogs regularly selling in the early one hundred and fifties. Cheviot hogs sold to a top of £157 weighing 46kg from J Burns Agri, Stockton on Tees. Herdwick cross hogs from GJ & ME Walker & Sons, Dunsop Bridge sold to £154 weighing 46kg.

There was just shy of 1000 horned hogs forward. Horned hogs in most demand were well finished hogs that weighed mid to late forty kilograms. Horned hogs weighing around 40kg often sold either side of 300p/kg with light weights keenly sought after today also selling around 300p/kg. Horned hogs topped at £153.50 for 48kg Swaledales from J Allinson & Sons, Arkengarthdale followed by others to £153 from JS & S Atkinson, Scorton and GJ & ME Walker & Sons, Dunsop Bridge with plenty of pens selling in the region of £150.

Rams 11 forward, A Hollings topped at £177 with a cheviot but some well fleshed Swales were up in trade at £160 for CJ & AJ Owen and then at £155 for R & PR Banks & Son.
