PRIME LAMBS

A good show of 1529 lambs forward today with well fed lambs readily bid on and trade would be very similar to last week without the Christmas Show. Beltex x lambs led the way today at £164 for JR Blades closely followed by WA Dinsdale & Son at £162 and JR & LA Capstick and R Mudd & Son both at £161. Texels were headed at £162 for WA Dinsdale & Son with 10 lots at £159 and above with plenty of lots in the £140's. Not many Suffolks forward but well meated with size were in the £140's with K Milburn & A Devlin heading at £152. With over 1/3 of the sale been Mules once again Hawes had some very good runs with plenty of size and well fed leading the prices were R & H Hird at £155 followed by T Metcalfe at £151 with the top pp/kg going to K Milburn and A Devlin at 302p/kg followed by a pen of clipped lambs from J Scarr & Sons at 300p with an average of 287p/kg for 561 Mules. Strong Swaledales forward from DJ Amsden led both the prices at 270p/kg and £132.50 but two strong pens from JE Cowperthwaite followed at £131.50 and £130 only the leaner smaller tup lambs would be less on the week.
