### **Gimmer Shearlings**

The Calvert consignment of Swaledale gimmer shearlings averaged an impressive £240.08. Other leading prices included E.W. Atkinson, Arkengarthdale, who sold to £215. The overall average for all gimmer shearlings forward was £180.56.

### **Gimmer Lambs**

A buoyant trade was also witnessed for Swaledale gimmer lambs, with demand strong from start to finish and interest shown from both local and travelled buyers. Powerful, dark gimmer hoggs were particularly sought after, with the best regularly exceeding the £150 mark. Leading the way was the first-prize pen from J.W. Porter & Sons, Gunnerside, achieving £290. The second-prize pen from R.S. Harker & Son, Grayrigg, realised £220, with the third-prize pen from G. Harker & Son, Arkengarthdale, also selling to £220. Other notable prices included J.S. Calvert, Reeth, at £215; D. Hodgson, Askrigg, at £210; and J.T. Dixon & Son, Bellerby, closing the sale with a pen at £205. The overall market average for gimmer lambs was £116.73, representing an increase of £28 on the year, with very few pens selling below the £60 mark.
